## **Solemn declaration on signed agreement on annual inspection**

The undersigned company hereby confirms to be aware that there shall be an agreement about annual inspection between the company and an impartial, accredited inspection body. This is to ensure that the requirements for obtaining approval of the building component for use with drinking water are being complied with by the approval holder during the approval period of the building component.

The inspection shall be carried out as an accredited inspection, i.e. inspection performed as an accredited service by an impartial third-party, which has been accredited for the inspection in question by the Danish Accreditation and Metrology Fund (DANAK) or a similar accreditation body, which is a signatory to the EA MLA (Multilateral Agreement of the European co-operation for Accreditation) or the ILAC MRA (Mutual Recognition Arrangement of the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation). The inspection body must be accredited according to EN ISO/IEC 17020 to carry out inspection concerning the approval scheme for building components in contact with drinking water.

The agreement on inspection shall ensure that documentation is available to the Danish Transport, Construction and Housing Authority proving that the approved building component that is placed on the market and sold has the health properties, which the Danish Transport, Construction and Housing Authority has assessed, and that the company continues to comply with the conditions for the establishment of an own-control programme.

The requirements are stated in section 11 and section 12, subsection 1, of Executive Order no. 1007 of 29 June 2016 on placement on the market and sale of building components that come into contact with drinking water.

In accordance with the above provisions the undersigned company hereby solemnly declares:

- that the company has entered into an agreement (conditional/final) with an accredited inspection body about carrying out an annual inspection concerning the building component applied for, and
- that the company as the holder of the approval will submit the final inspection agreement for the approved building component to Danish Transport, Construction and Housing Authority no later than two months before the first inspection is carried out.
